Heritage Sabbath is October 30th

Every year in the fall around the birthday of our church we celebrate Heritage Sabbath both in gratitude for what God has done in our past and in faith for the heritage the Lord is building in us for the future. This year's Heritage Sabbath will take place on October 30th. The theme for this year is spiritual leadership.

What is a spiritual leader? There are all kinds of leaders in the world, but one of the common traits for a leader is that someone is following them. Spiritual leaders don't need to have a leadership role or a title or even to be recognized by very many people as a spiritual leader. They are simply ordinary people who because they follow Jesus have qualities that are worthy of being imitated.

The apostle Paul gets to this idea when writing to Timothy. He told him to, "Follow the pattern of the sound words that you have heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus." (2 Timothy 1:13) Notice that Paul highlights both the pattern of sound words and the faith and love of Jesus. It's both Paul's understanding of the truth of God's Word in addition to Paul's lifestyle of trusting in Jesus and living out the love of Jesus.

Paul was a spiritual leader be-

cause he followed Jesus both in understanding the truth of God's Word and in living according to the truth of God's Word. That's what the heartbeat of every Jesus person should be! That's just being a disciple of Jesus!

The world around us in so many ways hasn't a clue about Jesus and how amazing it is to know him. I hope that you have in your heart a desire, from the Lord, to be a spiritual influence on both those who don't know him and on those who do know him. If we are all pointing each other to Jesus, that is going to be a powerful example of spiritual leadership in the world!

I hope you plan to take advantage of the events of Heritage Sabbath. There will be worship, fellowship, teaching, and some really good food. It is going to be a blessed time!!



In these trying times it's good to hear some encouraging news. Considering the youth we work with here in the Koinonia Youth Ministries, here is some good news.

School has started which can be a challenge for many youth, but many youth here with us have taken it on as a positive challenge. One positive thing that arose to give opportunities for kids going back to school was a youth rally sponsored by a group of youth leaders from the area to help kids to start bible clubs in their schools. A representative from the National School Project came in to encourage the youth and provide kids resources to lead these bible meetings at their schools. At the rally there were students who stood to say they would

step up to be organizers and leaders in their schools.



The bible meetings will happen once a week and be student led; which is an exciting thing to see young people step up to be leaders in Christ. One of the groups started this morning in their school and the young leaders enthusiastically posted on their message page that there were 28 kids signed up to attend and more kids were going to attend remotely.

One of the young men who has been home schooled most of his life decided to go to public school, and also play football, is one of those leaders of a group already in his school. He said he went to the office to inquire about starting the bible club and found the advisors to help make it happen.

This is happening in about 6 to 8 schools in Rock County, so we ask that you pray for these kids and the schools that they are being Mini Missionaries to.

September 22 was the national event 'See You At The Pole' where youth all over the country circle around their flag poles to pray for their schools and the peers attending. Even though the event will have already happened by time you receive this letter, please pray that more time like this will happen in the future.

When things like these happen, we need to encourage each other with the good news and encourage each other that the Lord continues to accomplish His work in the lives of young people, and all people. Praise the Lord!!!

To My Church Family by Rick Mullen, Trustee

I am writing to you on behalf of the Board of Trustees to give you an update on our capital campaign. Back at the beginning of 2019, the church voted to begin raising funds for necessary repairs on our church building. Thanks to your faithful giving we have been able to make many of the repairs and upgrades. The bell tower roof was replaced. The education wing masonry was repaired and repainted. The new bathroom was added, which included updates to the hallway and drinking fountain. We were able to update the lighting systems throughout the church to cost-saving LED lights. There are additional projects that need to be completed - the re-plastering of the bell tower stairway and in the kitchen, along with other smaller repairs.
